





TIM BROOKSHIRE

Tim Brookshire is a highly skilled instructor with over 25 years of combined law enforcement and security experience. He has traveled to countries such as Bulgaria, Brazil, and Afghanistan, teaching Situational Leadership II, Executive Coaching, and advanced police combative techniques to police officers and military personnel.

In 1992, Tim Brookshire began his career in law enforcement, progressing through various roles including advanced officer training, SWAT, and criminal investigations before ultimately becoming Chief of Police at the Clifton Police Department in Arizona. He has also shared his expertise internationally by working with Afghan law enforcement officials as a professional mentor and coach.

Tim has worked for the:

- U.S. Department of Defense, where he assisted in the development of the civilian policing model for the United States Marine Corps.
- U.S. Department of Homeland Security/Transportation Security Administration, specifically for the SPOT Program or Screening Passengers through Observation Techniques, where he managed a department with over 65 Behavior Detection Officers (BDOs).

BILL AMATO

Bill is the Immediate Past Chairperson of the International Association of Chiefs of Police Legal Officers Section. Additionally, Bill is an Arizona POST subject matter expert and trainer on Law and Legal as well as Defensive Tactics (first non-sworn member of this SME group).

Since joining the firm, Bill has continued his involvement with the IACP. He created the Annual Mid-Year Training Conference for the Legal Officer's Section. He continues to present nationally on a variety of law enforcement topics and provide consultation on use of force incidents, policy implementation, implicit bias and force review. As a scholar, educator, advisor, and consultant, Dr. Wilson has collaborated with police agencies, multinational corporations, communities, task forces, professional associations, governments, and other public and private entities on many complex public safety problems.



He has led over \$15M of sponsored projects and he has written over 180 publications on staffing and personnel planning, organizational consolidation, resource allocation, performance assessment and ROI, community policing, violence prevention, data and measurement, empirical modeling and evaluation. He is currently leading multiple national platforms of police staffing research for the US Department of Justice.

For his contributions to police research and practice, he was named a Distinguished Scholar by the American Society of Criminology Division on Policing, and the Police Section of the Academy of Criminal Justice Sciences honored him with the O.W. Chris Timmins is the Co-Founder and Vice President of Preston’s Pursuit for Acceptance (PPA). Chris retired in May of 2025 after twenty-five years in law enforcement in the Phoenix Metropolitan area, spanning over three agencies. His last position in Law Enforcement was the position of Employee Services Lieutenant, which manages the Hiring/Recruiting and Peer Support/Officer Wellness Units for his agency.

Chris has held positions in Detention/Corrections, Crime Scene Investigation Unit, Patrol Division, Field Training Unit, DUI Traffic Enforcement Unit, Robbery/Homicide Unit, Intelligence Unit, Narcotics Unit, Criminal Apprehension Team, and management in addition to his current role/position. Chris has been a defensive tactics instructor, use of force instructor, and electronic control device instructor (S.M.E.) for almost two decades. Chris has specialized training in impaired driving detection and apprehension, and many other modalities within law enforcement.

Chris is a transformational leader, innovative thinker, and tactically minded with a focus on professional policing practices, especially focusing on positive interactions with those within the disability community. Chris has been influential in creating a cultural shift at his current agency in autism awareness and acceptance. Chris is a husband and father, and his family has influenced his views on policing through having meaningful, positive interactions with the community while still protecting and serving with high morals, ethics, and professionalism, and again especially for those individuals with a disability.

During Chris’ career, he saw a societal and cultural shift in expectations for policing in America and firsthand saw the lack of training provided to first responders for autism awareness. This void has prompted him and Autumn to make a change in the way first responders are equipped to protect and serve their communities. Through education, collaboration, and exercises, first responders can make a positive difference in the effectiveness of service brought to those individuals on the spectrum, as well as all of society.



Chris has been married to his wife, Autumn, for twenty-three years, and together they have two amazing children. Their oldest son was diagnosed at an early age with autism. This has driven both Chris and Autumn to make a difference, and through PPA, they intend to make a change.

2025 OFFICER OF THE YEAR

In the early morning hours of Sunday, May 25, 2025, at approximately 4:23 a.m., Goodyear Police Officer Dakota Berry was returning to the city after completing a suspect booking at the Intake, Transfer and Release Facility (ITR). As he drove westbound on Interstate 10 near 91st Avenue, he encountered a catastrophic multi-vehicle collision—one vehicle fully engulfed in flames.

Trapped inside the burning car was a lone female driver, frantically sounding the horn in a desperate plea for help. Without regard for his own safety, Officer Berry acted decisively and heroically. He broke the driver's side window, reached into the inferno, and pulled the woman—whose hair was on fire—from the engulfed vehicle.

Realizing the flames on the woman's body were still active, Officer Berry immediately used his bare hands to extinguish the fire, knowingly putting himself at extreme risk. In doing so, he sustained significant burn injuries. After suppressing the flames on the victim, he located and used a fire extinguisher to eliminate the remaining fire on her person.

Thanks to his courageous actions, the victim—later identified as the daughter of a Goodyear firefighter—was transported in critical condition to a burn center, where she survived and continues to recover. Officer Berry was also treated at a local burn center and made a full recovery from his injuries.

Officer Berry's actions that morning were nothing short of extraordinary. His quick thinking, fearless intervention, and unwavering dedication to duty unquestionably saved the woman's life. His selfless courage, even in the face of immediate and life-threatening danger, reflects the highest ideals of policing and public service.

The incident was captured in graphic detail by Officer Berry's body-worn camera, drawing national attention and praise. Goodyear Police Chief Brian Issitt publicly commended Officer Berry, stating:

"This heroic and selfless act exemplifies the bravery and commitment of our officers to serve and protect, often at great personal risk. His quick thinking and fearless actions undoubtedly saved a life that morning. We are immensely proud of our officer's courage. This incident is a powerful reminder of the strength of our public safety family and the extraordinary sacrifices made in service to others."

Officer Dakota Berry's heroism exemplifies the core principles of courage, integrity, and service. It is with the utmost respect and deep admiration that I submit this nomination for the Arizona Department of Public Safety Medal of Valor in recognition of his exceptional service in the line of duty.
