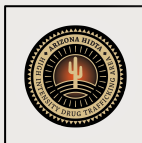
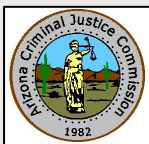

From Flagstaff: Travel south on I-17 approximately 3 miles to exit 337. This is the exit for both the Fort Tuthill County Park and the Flagstaff Airport.

After exiting I-17, travel west to the large round-about, then continue west from the roundabout into the Fort Tuthill County Park.
